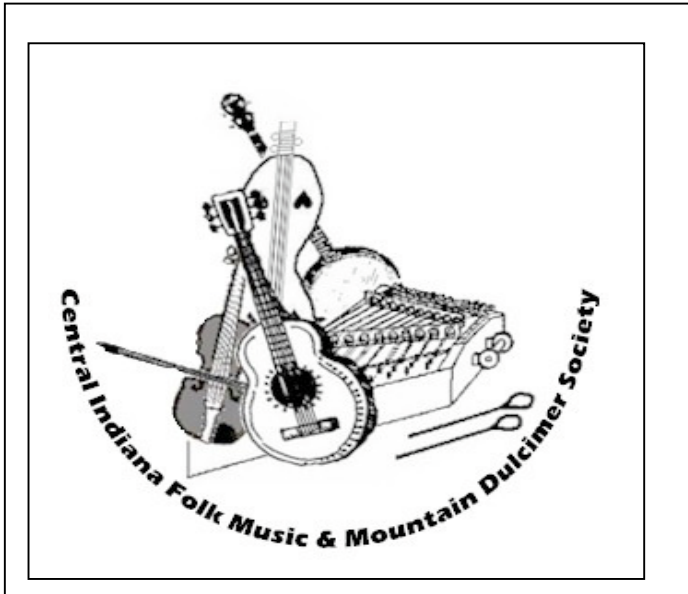

ENTERING THE PARK -

Names of the main stage performers, workshop teachers and volunteers who have signed up will be given to the two gates (71st St and 56th St) so that you can enter the park without paying the \$5 gate admission. When you arrive at the Marina, please check in with the volunteers at Festival Central (at a table under the RV awning).

They'll be able to help you with:

- getting your badge
- direct you to your workshop area and/or the main stage
- where you'll meet the stage managers

The stage managers will let you know where and when to be prior to your performance or workshop. Please stay in touch with the Stage Managers or within earshot of the PA system.

SET UP CREW -

Workshop area will be denoted by letters – Workshop Areas A, B, C and D. Someone will be there by 9:00 am to designate which letter will be in each location. Look for the people with STAFF or VOLUNTEER on their badges.

WHAT'S ON SITE -

There is a snack shop by the parking lot where drinks, candy and ice cream are available for purchase. Last year, the snack shop vendor did not have State Health Department inspections allowing them to sell prepared food within the newly renovated building. They are now up and operating, so there will be no trailer with a generator to contend with during the festival! There are also restrooms in this building.
